Park and Lake Actives

- *Hiedie Whittman Park Manager. Reports that a new gravel path was made by the nature center and on up to the office to keep foot traffic off the main road for safety. They are also working on docks. She also announced Stella in the office is leaving*

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Committee Report

- *Fox Island – Steve Strauser asks if the shelter house at Fax Island was going to be a project Dave Helgeson suggests that he and a group make an appointment with a State Representative and ask about helping to get funding or a shelter there because a catastrophic event happen to destroy it.*
- *Gateway Sign-Dale Frymyer reports that he and Chris Lamb the designer of the sign has been going though the drawings and they are making some alterations for cost purposes. This sign needs to be eye-catching to attract visitors and be ADA assessable. The approximate cost of the sign is estimated at \$50,000.00 - \$60,000.00*
- *Project Committee – Dennis Schaub reports that the LEC Tir County Recreation says they will be willing to pay for a data study in this area for a pedestrian pathway. Cynthia asks about the priority list and she was told that we do have a list and she wanted to know where the Gateway Sign is and told her on the top of the list. This list is available on request.*
- *Tree Fund – Rachel Kubic announced they will be another tree planting in the Spring to finish up the money that was received for this project*
- *Maple Syrup Festival- Dale Frymyer reports that the big tent is ordered for vendors. Supplies for breakfast are coming along good. Anyone wanting to help with this project is welcome.*

- *Chippewa Shelter- Rachel Kubic says they need a couple more quotes for the shelter, and they are real close to getting them.*
- *Memorial Benches – Dale Frymyer reports that he has one bench sold plus a flowerpot. Two other benches need pads poured for.*
- *Membership – Larry Blinn reports that dues letter as well as dock letters will be going out soon*
